Please have these items for the first day of school.

- *Pencil/crayon box @ least 12" inch
- *2 VERY Fine tip black permanent markers
- *Wide ruled notebook paper only. Please send a package of 100 sheets.
- * #2 pencils (2 packages of 72)...sent to school first day... Ticondra, American, PaperMate are good...generic brands (such as Office Max, etc.) are often difficult to sharpen and the leads break easily)
- *Colored pencil set (at least 20colors)
- *Box of Crayons (24 colors)
- * Scissors (Fiskers are terrific scissors) Buy the larger scissors
- * One large box of tissues for the classroom
- *Ruler (with inch and centimeter measures)
- *Watercolor set
- *2 Glue sticks
- *Two 2-pocket portfolios . . solid color..no decorations
- *5 subject dividers
- *White view binder (1-1/2")

Homework assignment during the summer: (These won't be recorded in any way, but sharing their summer experiences is a fun way to start off the new school year. They will also give your child continued writing practice during the summer)

Writing: Every two weeks or so have your child write about a fun activity in which they have participated. Have them use lots of details telling about what they did. They should write about four different activities. Bring papers to school on the first day. We'll share their experiences.

Math: Be sure to practice some math during the summer. Counting change (coins)...let your child pay at the register. Keep up on the adding and subtracting skills. We will continue to use those skills, as well as begin multiplication.

Reading: Have plenty of reading materials available for your child to read and share some important time by reading to and/or with your child. We also encourage you to join the summer reading program at the city library.

Cursive: Please do not learn cursive at home over the summer. We will begin in the fall, and would like to teach everyone in the same manner. Thanks!
