Live teaching mixed with self-guided, supported time for students to complete lessons assigned in Seesaw (K-2) and Google Classroom (3-12). Schools open for staff, but closed for access to most students. Students will complete daily health screenings, practice physical distancing, and wear cloth face coverings while at school. All other students will continue to participate in Home-based learning. Learning Management System (LMS) Hubs to support access for all. 	↑
3	<p style="text-align: center;">November 9, 2020*</p>  <p>3-4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students from Stage 2 and students in grades 3-4 in a hybrid model of two (2) days of on-site, in-person learning and three (3) days of remote, home-based learning. Students will complete daily health screenings, practice physical distancing, and wear cloth face coverings while at school. All other students will continue to participate in Home-based learning. Learning Management System (LMS) Hubs to support access for all. 	
4	<p style="text-align: center;">November 30, 2020*</p>  <p>5-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students from Stage 3 and students in grades 5-6 in a hybrid model of two (2) days of on-site, in-person learning and three (3) days of remote, home-based learning. Students will complete daily health screenings, practice physical distancing, and wear cloth face coverings while at school. All other students will continue to participate in Home-based learning. Learning Management System (LMS) Hubs to support access for all. 	↑
5	<p style="text-align: center;">January 4, 2021*</p>  <p>7-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students from Stage 4 and students in grades 7-8 in a hybrid model of two (2) days of on-site, in-person learning and three (3) days of remote, home-based learning. Students will complete daily health screenings, practice physical distancing, and wear cloth face coverings while at school. All other students will continue to participate in Home-based learning. Learning Management System (LMS) Hubs to support access for all. 	
6	<p style="text-align: center;">January 26, 2021*</p>  <p>9-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students from Stage 5 and students in grades 9-12 in a hybrid model. This hybrid model will consist of two (2) days of on-site, in-person learning and three (3) days of remote, home-based learning. Students will complete daily health screenings, practice physical distancing, and wear cloth face coverings while at school. 	↑
